Star Stars

MATERIALS

22—18x22" pieces (fat quarters)

22—2 1/2 x 21" strips (Four-
Patch units, border No. 3)

1/2 yard each solid red, green,
purple, orange, and blue (star
point units)

ASSEMBLE FOUR-PATCH UNITS

1. Sew together two assorted
print 2 1/2 x 21" strips to make a strip
set (Diagram 1). Press seam in one
direction. Repeat to make 67 strip
sets total.

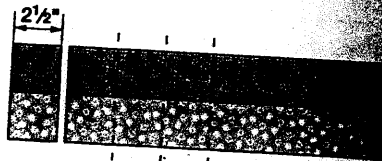

2. Cut strip sets into 2 1/2"-wide
segments for 532 two-patch units
total. Set aside 94 two-patch units
border No. 3.

3. Sew together two 2 1/2"-wide
segments to make a Four-Patch unit
(Diagram 2). Press seam in one
direction. The unit should be 4 3/4
square including seam allowances.
Repeat to make 219 Four-Patch
units total.

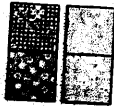

ASSEMBLE STAR POINT UNITS

1. Mark a diagonal line on wrong side
of each solid red, green, purple, orange
and blue 2 1/2" square.

2. Align and sew a marked solid
2 1/2" square to a corner of a solid
white 4 1/2" square (Diagram 3; note
direction of drawn line). Trim excess,
leaving 1/4" seam allowance; press
attached triangle open.

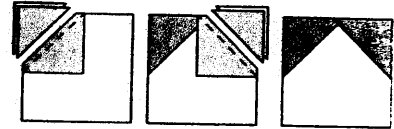

3. Align and sew a marked solid red
2 1/2" square to an adjacent corner of
the solid white 4 1/2" square (Diagram 3;
again note direction of drawn line).

Trim and press as before to make
a red star point unit. The unit still
should be 4 1/2" square including seam
allowances.

CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the order that follows.

From assorted 1930s prints, cut:

• 134—2 1/2 x 21" strips

From each solid red, green, purple, orange,
and blue, cut:

• 80—2 1/2" squares

From solid white, cut:

• 9—2 1/2 x 42" strips for border No. 1

• 218—4 1/2" squares

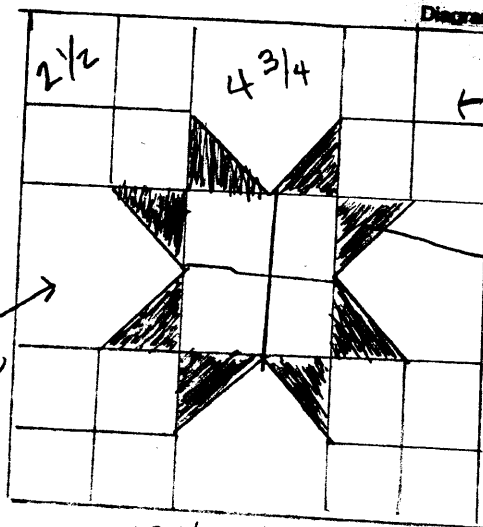
From solid yellow, cut:

• 10—2 1/2 x 42" strips for border No. 2

• 11—2 1/2 x 42" binding strips

• 10—2 1/4 x 42" strips for border No. 4
