

Friday, March 20, "Piec-lique"

Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine (single needle plate for you machine)

Size 75 machine embroidery needles

Piecing thread (beige/gray)

Firm pressing mat and iron (We may have to double up with our irons since we have a "full house" and we don't want electrical problems.)

Regular spray starch....no spray sizing

Freezer paper

Medium stencil brush

Water soluble basting glue

Permanent marking pen

Serger/surgical tweezers

Scissors, both paper and fabric

12 1/2" square ruler

Rotary cutter and mat (small rotary cutter)

Assorted fabrics...you'll probably have a better idea after the program

Saturday, March 21, "Domestic Machine Quilting"

6....22" squares of muslin (no polyester)

3....25" squares of batting You're making mini-quilt sandwiches for practice.

50 weight machine quilting thread (Signature or Star brands work best for beginners)

Blue water soluble pen

Sewing Machine in good working order(esp. feed dogs that drop) and the extension table for your machine if you have one

Single needle plate

90/14 machine embroider needles

Tweezers, thimble

100 per cent cotton tatting (or heavy weight) thread for basting and basting needle

Quilting gloves or glycerin for hands
