### Categories for 2010 Golden Triangle Quilt Guild Quilt Show (5)

Bed, One person – Appliqué, Pieced, Mixed Technique (1), Other (2)  
Bed, Two persons – Appliqué, Pieced, Mixed Technique (1), Other (2)  
Bed, Group – Appliqué, Pieced, Mixed Technique (1), Other (2)  
Wall, One person – Appliqué, Pieced, Mixed Technique (1), Other (2)  
Wall, Two persons – Appliqué, Pieced, Mixed Technique (1), Other (2)  
Wall, Group – Appliqué, Pieced, Mixed Technique (1), Other (2)  
Art – one or two person, any size  
Pictorial – one or two person, any size  
Miniature – small scale quilts  
Baby and Juvenile quilts – twin size or smaller  
Block of Month or Kit Quilts – where fabric is supplied  
Block of the month quilts – quilts made from blocks won in a drawing  
Bee quilt – one quilt made by the entire bee (3)  
Guild challenge to individuals –  
    1. Mardi Gras theme quilt – any size, any style depicting Mardi Gras colors or activities  
    2. Favorite song quilt – any size, any style which depicts or reflects your favorite song (6)  
Bee or Group challenges (4)  
Youth Quilts – makers under age 18 – sponsored by guild member

- (1) If quilt has both Appliqué and Piecing, entrant should enter in the Mixed Technique category unless one or the other is strongly dominant.
- (2) Other would include painted, whole cloth, etc. If not enough for a separate category, entries will be combined with another.
- (3) Bee quilt will be one quilt made by all or most of the bee members. Quilt is to become a donation for the 2011 guild auction. The bee may enter the quilt to be judged or displayed only. They will be hung together with signs stating, ***“If you would like to own this quilt, be sure to attend 2011 auction.”***
- (4) Groups or Bees who wish to have their own challenge category may do so if they have 6 or more entries being judged. They may have a separate category with any number if not being judged. Be sure to fill in the name of the group or bee on the entry form blank line provided.
- (5) All quilts will have hand or machine quilting designation. If quilt has both hand and machine quilting, entrant will indicate which is dominating in case there are enough to separate a category by hand and machine quilting. All of the categories listed will be further subdivided or combined to make an equitable distribution of quilts to be judged.
- (6) Guild challenge category “favorite song theme quilt” will not be judged but will be displayed together and have a separate “viewer’s choice ballot” for just that category to award ribbons.
