SHERRIE'S CHECK BOOK COVERS

Supplies Needed:

One fat quarter
Thread

Directions:

Cut two pieces of fabric 8" x 14.5" – one for the outside and one for the lining. Sandwich the two pieces of fabric together and stitch close to the edge all around. Turn top edges to inside ½" and topstitch down. With right side of fabric facing down, fold both sides up 2-1/2" and pin.

Using your check book make sure it will fit and then stitch down both sides using about a ¼" seam. Turn to outside and there you have it – a check book cover. I used two pieces of fabric but you can just use one if you like.

You can fuse fabric cutouts to the front or you can do a small paper pieced designs, etc. to decorate. Use your imagination and have fun!
