

BLOCK OF THE MONTH

"CHRISTMAS IN JULY"

Size: 12" finished

Red Christmas Print: Cut 2 squares $3\frac{7}{8}$ " by $3\frac{7}{8}$ ". Cut 1 square $4\frac{3}{4}$ " by $4\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Different Christmas Prints: Cut 16 squares 2" by 2"

Cream Print: Cut 4 squares $3\frac{7}{8}$ " by $3\frac{7}{8}$ " and then cut diagonally 2 to make 4 triangles. Other 2 squares go with step 1. Cut 16 squares 2" by 2".

STEP 1: On wrong side of $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cream and $3\frac{7}{8}$ " red christmas print draw diagonal line down center. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side and cut apart and press open.

STEP 2: Sew 8 four patches of cream and DIFFERENT christmas prints. These are all 2" squares.

STEP 3: Sew $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cream triangles to $4\frac{3}{4}$ " red christmas print to make a SQUARE-IN-SQUARE.

STEP 4: Sew units together.
