

## FOX & GEESE

Materials for block:

A - Dark Blue      B - Medium Blue      C - Background; Off White or Light Beige

From your Background, (Off White or Light Beige) (Fabric C,) cut:

4 - 3 1/2" squares

5 - 3 7/8" squares, cutting each in half for a total of 10 small triangles

From your Medium Blue (Fabric B) cut:

3 - 3 7/8" squares, cutting each in half for a total of 6 small triangles

From your Dark Blue (Fabric A) cut:

1 - 6 7/8" square, cutting in half for a total of 2 large half square triangles

### ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Step 1. Sew together one background (Fabric C) small triangle and one medium blue (Fabric B) small triangle to make a triangle square (Diagram 1). Repeat to make a total of six triangle-squares. Each triangle-square should measure 3 1/2" square.

Step 2. Sew together two triangle squares and two background (Fabric C) 3 1/2" squares in pairs (Diagram 2). Press seam allowances toward the background squares. Then join the pairs to make a Four-Patch unit. Press the seam allowance in one direction. The Four-Patch unit should measure 6 1/2" square. Repeat to make a second Four-Patch unit.

Step 3. Referring to Diagram 3 sew the two background (Fabric C) small triangles to a triangle-square to make a large pieced triangle. Press the seam allowances toward the background (Fabric C) triangles. Then join the long side of a Dark Blue (Fabric A) large triangle to the long side of the large pieced triangle to make a triangle unit. Press the seam allowance toward the Dark Blue (Fabric A) triangle. The triangle unit should measure 6 1/2" square. Repeat to make a second triangle unit.

Step 4. Sew together the Four-Patch units and triangle units in pairs. Press the seam allowances toward the Four-Patch units. Then join the pairs to make a block (Block Assembly Diagram).

NOTE: You may want to cut your small half-square triangles by cutting 4" squares of the Background (Fabric C) and 4" square of the Medium Blue (Fabric B) and placing the fabrics right sides together, drawing a line from corner to corner and stitching a 1/4" from both sides of

the marked line and cutting on the marked line. This will give you two units of half-square triangles of the Medium Blue fabric and the Background fabric. Then cut the unit to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square with your ruler or, by using your "Quilt In A Day" template.

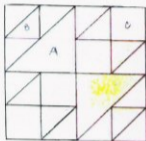


DIAGRAM 2
